Five days of "Keeping the Tradition Alive!" What better way to experience the Golden Age of Sail than on this 1882 two-mast Windjammer!

We will board Sunday evening, August 30 in Camden, Maine, and will set sail Monday morning, after a scrumptious breakfast, and go where the wind takes us on Penobscot Bay. The Windjammers were built as working ships during the age of sail and have been converted and certified for passenger cruises. The boats in the fleet have no engines; a yawl boat (Pusher boat) helps guide them into anchorages and serves as a tender for visits onto the shore/islands. Shore visits may change due to wind, but the 'Lobster Bake' meal on an island is a highlight that doesn't change.

On Friday, September 4, we disembark in Camden at about 10 a.m. The annual *Camden Windjammer Festival* begins at noon with a parade into Camden Bay, The festivities continue with music, entertainment, a lobster feast (no charge), and fireworks to top off the evening!

You won't want to miss this celebration! Make your lodging reservations ASAP for Friday p.m. layover or stay Labor Day weekend. Check out the local hotels or Airbnb's.
